Bees are found all over the world except **Antartica**

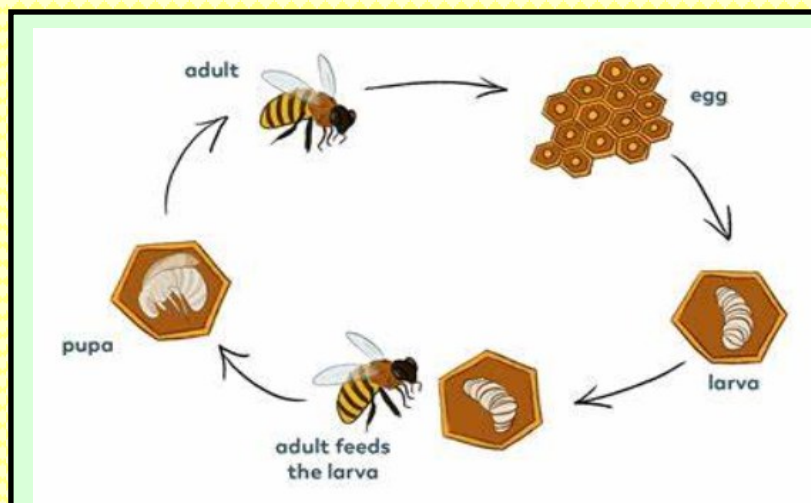
Bees have **5 eyes** and **6 legs**
