Dear parents/ carers,

I hope I find you all having enjoyed a Summer with a healthy balance of rest and adventure and ready to begin the new academic year. To those of you who are existing IKB families, welcome back to another academic year! To those who are joining us at IKB or Orchard Grove this September for the first time, welcome to our school community! It is with great excitement that I write to you today because it feels like the beginning of a new chapter for both schools. For Orchard Grove, this September marks the existence of our school and the first ever cohort of children and families attending as well as the opportunity to lay strong foundations for all families who follow. For IKB we are entering our fourth year since opening and no longer can we call ourselves the 'new' school. We feel firmly established within the Wellington community now and have an ever growing positive reputation for every child belonging, participating and achieving. Our challenge is to continue and ensure that we transfer this into Key Stage 2 as our children move into Year 3 and beyond over the coming years.

As you are all aware, from September our schools are now part of The Blackdown Education Partnership (BEP), merging together what were formerly The Castle Partnership Trust and Uffculme Academy Trust. This is an exciting time for all our schools, providing the opportunity to enhance our educational provision, especially



for our most vulnerable pupils and families. It also allows us to invest in wider opportunities for staff development and wellbeing, and to bolster our organisational resilience at a time when education is facing significant challenge. Our commitment within the BEP will be 'Belief in every child' and I hope that you will see this being strongly recognised within your own children at both IKB and Orchard Grove.

Returning to School

Please note that school and nursery will be closed on Monday 4th September and Tuesday 5th September for staff training days to allow us to have everything prepared for your children upon their return. Nursery, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 children will all return on Wednesday 6th September. Knowledge Organisers and Class Newsletters


