Home Learning:

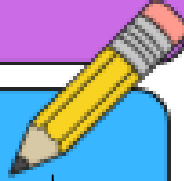
Please read with your child 5 times a week for 5 minutes as well as continuing to practise their key word and high frequency word sheets. Books will be changed on a Friday.
